The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in special session on Wednesday, January 2, 2013 at the Concord Township Administrative Building to organize for 2013.

The Fiscal Officer, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m. The roll was called: present were Trustees Karen Koch, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Several corrections were noted. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the minutes as corrected. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The Fiscal Officer opened the floor for nominations for 2013 Chairman of the Board. Mr. Garrett moved to nominate Ms. Koch for Chairman. Mr. Johnson seconded this motion. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to close nominations. Vote to close nominations: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Vote for Ms. Koch chairman: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The Fiscal Officer opened the floor for nominations for 2013 Vice Chairman of the Board. Mr. Johnson moved and Ms. Koch seconded to nominate Mr. Garrett for Vice Chairman. As there were no other nominations, upon roll call vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Ms. Koch moved to appoint Mr. Johnson to serve as Executive Board member. Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The meeting was turned over to 2013 Chairman, Ms. Karen Koch.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

It was noted the Board of Trustees will hold their regular township meetings on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, as approved at the last meeting, except for Memorial Day and end of year meeting. Meeting dates will begin at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015, and will be published in the Delaware Gazette.

The Fiscal Officer presented the 2013 Township Annual Appropriations. Mr. Garrett moved the adoption of the following Resolution (#010213-1): Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Trustees, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year, as follows:

Ms. Koch seconded the Resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Reports were distributed for 2012 final payroll, end of year fund balances and purchase orders.

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adopt a Resolution (#010213-2) allowing the Fiscal Officer, in the event there is an inadequate amount in the line item or appropriation to pay incoming bills, to make the necessary inter-fund transfers as needed to meet obligations. Vote: Kochyes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adopt a Resolution (#010213-3) approving the use of township funds for payment of Delaware County Regional Planning Commission dues for 2013, calculated at a population of  $10,076 \times 1.04$  per person, minus a credit of \$1,183.00 for end of 2011 population 9,857 x -\$0.12, all totaling \$9,296.00. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved to allow the Fiscal Officer to invest township funds in the best interest of the Township as prescribed by the Ohio Revised Code. These monies are invested in reputable financial institutions which have a contract with Concord Township for Deposit of Public Funds. PNC Bank, Delaware County Bank, and Insight Bank are currently used. Fiscal Officer Davis intends to add the State of Ohio's StarOhio and StarPlus programs during 2013. Mr. Johnson seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the Trustee's road inspection assignments. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Discussion was held on the Zoning Fee Schedule. Per the previous meeting, Zoning Inspector Irvine noted the Certificate of Compliance fees are often not included in permit applications due to the structure of the fee schedule. Room additions and detached garages are also calculated completely different. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to submit the following changes to the Zoning Fee Schedule: 1-remove the additional \$10 per square foot fee on residential applications, 2-remove the Certificate of Compliance fee for residential and commercial applications and note

"included in fee," 3-remove additional per square foot fees for garage or residence additions, or decks. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Ms. Koch moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to continue with the current Cemetery Fees Schedule. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to appoint Nick Cua to the Board of Zoning Appeals for another five-year term through December 31, 2017. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

It was noted 2013 Road Improvement request forms will be received this month and due back to the Delaware County Engineer's Office in February. Roads inspection will be scheduled later this month

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve a \$40.00 per month cell phone reimbursement for 2013 for part-time Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve the following pay changes for 2013: Director of Operations (part-time) increase \$1,500 per year, Zoning Inspector (part-time) and Road Department (full-time) increase two percent per year, and all other Administrative and Maintenance positions no change. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

It was noted the Fire Department full-time staff will receive a four percent raise for 2013, but will also have an additional two percent deducted from their pay toward pensions, per the approved Local Union #3755 contract dated June 25, 2012. Fire department part-time staff pay rates will remain the same. Ms. Koch moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to increase the Fire Chief pay rate four percent, with the additional two percent pension deduction. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Mr. Johnson noted our Fire Department is in excellent position thanks to Chief Cooper overseeing the budget in a conservative manner. Mr. Garrett added, due to the Chief's work, we are not in bad shape as other townships.

The Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund pick-up resolution needs updated due to full-time fire department staff paying an additional two percent toward their employee pensions and the township's pick-up being reduced two percent. Therefore, Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve a resolution to decrease the township's pick-up of the full-time fire employee's portion of pension from six percent to four percent. The employee will now pay six percent of their mandatory ten percent pension, with the township covering four percent of the employee's portion. The employer's portion remains unchanged at twenty-four percent. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-ves.

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to name Loveland & Brosius, LLC law firm as township outside legal counsel on an as-needed, hourly basis for calendar year 2013, at the discretion of the Director of Operations, not to exceed total compensation of \$5,000.00. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Year-end financials were reviewed, and payroll direct deposit vouchers #1098-1101, totaling \$58,969.58, were approved and signed.

As there was no further business, Mr. Johnson moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Garrett. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Meeting adjourned.

WHEREAS, the Concord Township Board of Township Trustees ("Board") is authorized by Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code to employ attorneys on an annual basis other than the prosecuting attorney to represent the Township and its officers, boards and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them on legal matters; and

WHEREAS, Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code provides that no such attorney may be employed except on the order of the Board, duly entered upon its Journal, in which the compensation to be paid for the attorney's legal services shall be fixed; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary to appoint attorneys to counsel and represent the Township on an annual basis for calendar year 2013 in such matters as the Board or its designee may refer to them; and

WHEREAS, the Board has appropriated the sum of \$ 5,000.00 for legal services for 2013;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Donald F. Brosius of Loveland & Brosius, LLC, and the law firm of Loveland & Brosius, LLC, 50 West Broad Street, Suite 3300, Columbus, Ohio 43215, are hereby employed on an annual basis for calendar year 2013 as the Township's legal counsel to represent the Township and its officers, boards and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them in connection with such matters as may be referred to said Counsel by or on behalf of the Board or its designee.

SECTION 2. The compensation for such counsel during 2013 shall be paid as follows: \$195.00 per hour partner attorney time; \$175.00 per hour senior associate time; \$150.00 per hour associate time; \$90.00 per hour law clerk time; and \$75.00 per hour legal assistant time; plus out-of-pocket expense reimbursements; provided that the total compensation shall not exceed \$5,000.00 without further action by this Board.

SECTION 3. The attorneys may be discharged at any time by majority vote of the Board.

SECTION 4. The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the law firm.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including, without limitation, Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.
