

Call to Order and Roll Call

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Wednesday, April 12, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Community Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio. Chairman Bart Johnson called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Bart Johnson, Jason Haney, and Joe Garrett.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2023 regular meeting. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-abstain/absent, Johnson-yes.

Public Input

Ms. Lori Kannally with the Delaware General Health District discussed the following:

- A Pool & Spa Operators Class held on May 11, 2023 at the YMCA from 9am-12pm.
- The Delaware County and Concord Township Community Profiles were distributed.
- Health department will move to new facility the week of May 13-18.
- Inquiry of how many miles of trails in the county.

Approval of Financial Report

Trustee Johnson certified Fiscal Officer Jill Davis provided the current financial reports of the township, and money is available to pay bills. The current Cash Summary by Fund report (see attached) shows the following balances:

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve pending purchase orders and warrants #29-33, 116916-116961, all totaling \$299,361.40. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Zoning Department

Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine reported the following:

- Zoning issued 20 permits since the last meeting: 10 homes, 4 additions, 3 accessory buildings, 2 gazebos, 1 pool.
- Clancey residence notice on Riverside Drive was returned undeliverable. Another notice was sent via Fedex letter. Notice will be advertised in paper if no response, then onto Prosecutor's Office for action.
- The Board of Zoning Appeals met April 4. John Kipfer was elected Chairman, Daren Webb was elected Vice Chairman. A rear setback variance was approved on Home Road. There is another meeting on May 2 for a Hyatts Road barn in front of the house.
- Mr. Irvine met with Dave Ganim who is wanting to expand the US42 pickleball facility.
- Mr. Irvine met with Adaptive Sports on Harriott Drive regarding a City of Columbus property that will be renovated for veterans programs. Ric suggested they bring the project to Zoning Commission for possible PCD use and approval.
- No progress or response on Riverside Drive rehabilitation facility.
- A denied zoning project may be restarted and submitted in the future.

Road Department

Road Supervisor Nathan Wilgus discussed the following:

- Cyrus Construction has started ADA ramp replacements off Morris Road. A few irrigation lines have been repaired.
- Chemcote showed up to repair the Springberry Court asphalt that was approved last fall. Several other roads in that same area will need crack-filled this summer, and some were installed inconsistently.
- Columbia Gas patched the hole on Concord Road.
- A drain will be installed near a Klondike Road driveway to help catch rain runoff across the road. Supplies will be purchased to begin soon. Trees were also removed along Klondike curve to improve line of sight.
- Chainsaw safety gear was purchased.
- Quotes were received for a new 24'x40'x9' park shelter building behind the fire station as part of the current park grant. Motion was made by Mr. Garrett and seconded by Mr. Haney to contract with Kirkham Building System Inc for the construction of a park shelter at a cost of \$40,652. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Concrete for the shelter will be bid at a later date. The shelter placement will allow additional pickleball courts to be installed in the future, along with restrooms.
- Pickleball wind screen was ordered, delivered and will be installed soon.



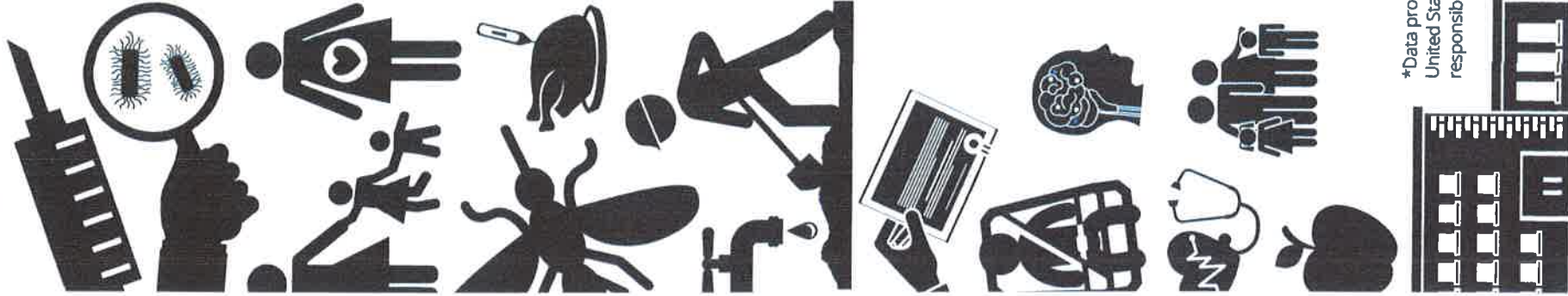

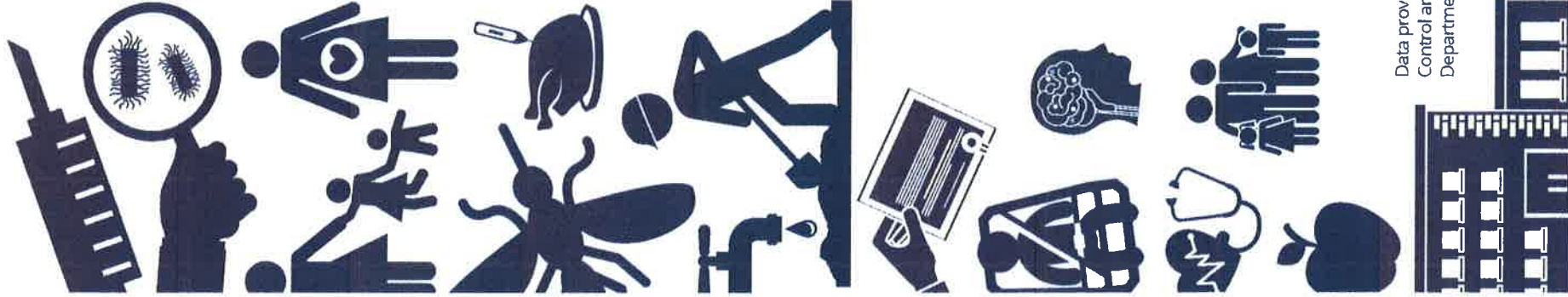
