The Board of Trustees of Concord Township met in special session on Tuesday, January 3, 2012 at the Concord Township Administrative Building to organize for 2012.

The Fiscal Officer, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. The roll was called; present were Trustees Karen Koch, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Three corrections were noted. Mr. Johnson moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Ms. Koch seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The Fiscal Officer opened the floor for nominations for 2012 Chairman of the Board. Mr. Garrett moved to nominate Ms. Koch for Chairman. Mr. Johnson seconded this motion. As there were no other nominations, upon roll call vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The Fiscal Officer opened the floor for nominations for 2012 Vice Chairman of the Board. Mr. Garrett moved to nominate Mr. Johnson for Vice Chairman. Ms. Koch seconded this motion. As there were no other nominations, upon roll call vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved to appoint Mr. Garrett to serve as Executive Board member. Ms. Koch seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The meeting was then turned over to 2012 Chairman, Ms. Karen Koch.

NEW BUSINESS

It was noted the Board of Trustees will hold their regular township meetings on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, as approved at the last meeting, except for Memorial Day and Christmas Eve. Meeting dates will be published in the Delaware Gazette, and will begin at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015.

Mr. Garrett moved to allow the Fiscal Officer to invest township funds in the best interest of the Township as prescribed by Ohio Revised Code. These monies are invested in reputable financial institutions which have a contract with Concord Township for Deposit of Public Funds. PNC Bank, Delaware County Bank, and Insight Bank are currently used. Mr. Johnson seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Ms. Koch moved to approve the trustee's road inspection assignments, unchanged from 2011 (attached). Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved to continue with the current Zoning Fee Schedule (v. July 28, 2005). Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. The Board of Trustees would like the Zoning Inspector to review and suggest any fee changes.

Mr. Garrett moved to continue with the current Cemetery Fee Schedule. Ms. Koch seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Discussion was held on possible interment areas and burial rules.

The Fiscal Officer presented the 2012 Township Annual Appropriations. Mr. Johnson moved the adoption of the following Resolution (010312-1): Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Trustees, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2012, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year, as follows:

Mr. Garrett seconded the Resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Discussion was held on 2011 carryover balances by fund, and how the 2012 county certificate and township appropriations are calculated.

Mr. Johnson moved to adopt a Resolution (010312-2) allowing the Fiscal Officer, in the event there is an inadequate amount in the line item or appropriation to pay incoming bills, to make the necessary inter-fund transfers as needed to meet obligations. Mr. Garrett seconded this Resolution. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved to maintain 2011 pay rates into 2012 for township employees, including road/maintenance, zoning and administrative departments. Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Correspondence was received from Delaware County Prosecuting Attorney, Carol O'Brien, regarding the request for contributions by the Delaware Area Transit Board. After review of the Ohio Revised Code, the Prosecutor was unable to locate and is unaware of any authority that authorizes a township to contribute funding to a county transit board. Therefore, the township lacks authority to make the requested contribution. The transit board was also notified of the opinion, sent out apology letters for local funding support for the transit system (DATA Bus), and will return any contributions that have been received. Discussion continued as the Trustees wondered how supporting a service for township residents is not allowed.

Mr. Johnson moved to adopt a Resolution (010312-3) approving the use of township funds for payment of Delaware County Regional Planning Commission dues for 2012, calculated at a population of 9857 x \$1.04 per person, totaling \$10,251.00. Mr. Garrett seconded this Resolution. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

Mr. Johnson moved to continue the services by Dennis Bambach, MD as medical director to Concord Township EMS, including timely review of EMS runs and reports with appropriate teaching, approximately quarterly didactic sessions offered to the entire EMS staff, review and advisement of protocols, review and sign drug license, and general medical director for the calendar year 2012, for the fee of \$7,000.00. Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The full-time fire staff salaries are in the process of negotiation for the Union contract renewal.

Mr. Garrett moved to maintain 2011 pay rates into 2012 for township part-time fire staff. Mr. Johnson seconded this motion. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to maintain the 2011 Fire Chief's salary into 2012. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved to adopt the Resolution (010312-4) that Loveland & Brosius, LLC law firm be retained on an as-needed, hourly basis for calendar year 2012 to represent the Township as its outside legal counsel, not to exceed total compensation of \$5,000.00. Mr. Johnson seconded the adoption of this Resolution. Vote: Koch-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Year-end payroll vouchers #973-976, totaling \$56,985.11, were approved and signed.

As there was no further business, Mr. Garrett moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Johnson. Vote: Kochyes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

RESOLUTION EMPLOYING TOWNSHIP'S ATTORNEYS ON AN ANNUAL BASIS FOR THE YEAR 2012

WHEREAS, the Concord Township Board of Township Trustees ("Board") is authorized by Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code to employ attorneys on an annual basis other than the prosecuting attorney to represent the Township and its officers, boards and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them on legal matters; and

WHEREAS, Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code provides that no such attorney may be employed except on the order of the Board, duly entered upon its Journal, in which the compensation to be paid for the attorney's legal services shall be fixed; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary to appoint attorneys to counsel and represent the Township on an annual basis for calendar year 2012 in such matters as the Board or its designee may refer to them; and

WHEREAS, the Board has appropriated the sum of \$_5,000 for legal services for 2012;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Donald F. Brosius of Loveland & Brosius, LLC, and the law firm of Loveland & Brosius, LLC, 50 West Broad Street, Suite 3300, Columbus, Ohio 43215, are hereby employed on an annual basis for calendar year 2012 as the Township's legal counsel to represent the Township and its officers, boards and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them in connection with such matters as may be referred to said Counsel by or on behalf of the Board or its designee.

SECTION 2. The compensation for such counsel during 2012 shall be paid as follows: \$195.00 per hour partner attorney time; \$175.00 per hour senior associate time; \$150.00 per hour associate time; \$90.00 per hour law clerk time; and \$75.00 per hour legal assistant time; plus out-of-pocket expense reimbursements; provided that the total compensation shall not exceed without further action by this Board.

SECTION 3. The attorneys may be discharged at any time by majority vote of the Board.

SECTION 4. The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the law firm.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including, without limitation, Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.
