

Concord Township Recycling and Waste Guide

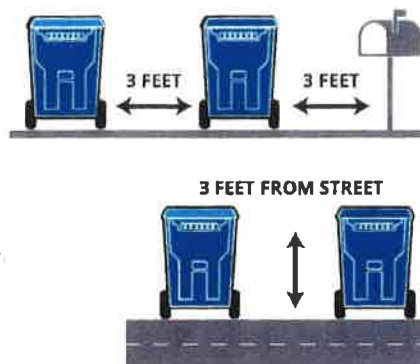
Waste collection is weekly. Curbside recycling collection in containers is every week.



Container Placement Rules

Follow these simple steps to ensure your recyclables and waste are collected quickly and easily:

- All recycling and waste must be placed at the curb.
- On your scheduled day of service, place your containers at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m.
- Position your containers no further than 3 feet away from the road with handle facing toward your residence.
- Position your containers 3 feet away from any obstacles, such as mailbox or light pole.
- Do not park your car in front of the container.
- Place all recyclables inside your container and do not overfill the container.
- Break down all boxes and if they don't fit into your container, wrap them with a string or masking tape.



Recycling Rules

Acceptable Items:

- Clean paper, cardboard (OCC) and newsprint
- Glass food and beverage containers (all colors)
- Rigid plastic food and beverage containers (#1 through #2)
- Steel, aluminum and bi-metal food and beverage containers
- Gable-top milk, gravy and soup cartons

All items should be rinsed and free of contaminants. These are the only items you should place in your recycle container.

Non-Acceptable Items:

- Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
- Containers with food and liquid residue remaining
- Pizza boxes and wet paper products
- Garden hoses and extension cords
- All metals except for those identified as acceptable

Waste Rules - the following items will NOT be collected in the trash under this program

- Steel drums
- Pharmaceuticals
- Hazardous or bio-hazard material
- Asbestos
- Ashes
- Paint and solvents or any other liquids
- Tires, lead acid batteries and car parts
- Items over 50 pounds

Recycling and household waste is scheduled to be collected on the same day, Monday through Thursday. Please consider signing up for **My Resource™** by logging onto **RepublicServices.com** to pay bills, get service updates and obtain added services.
