The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on June 24, 2020 at 7:00 pm at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio. Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order and the roll was called. In attendance were Trustees Bart Johnson, Joe Garrett, and Jason Haney. Other staff attending included Fiscal Officer Jill Davis, Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine, Road Supervisor Joe Holloway, and Fire Chief Todd Cooper.

Due to COVID-19 social distancing restrictions, limited seating was provided, and public teleconference information was posted on the township's website.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting June 10, 2020. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Public

Mr. Curt Schneider of Klondike Road called in to share his concern for speeding on Klondike Road.

- Mr. Schneider requested the speed limit be lowered.
- After discussion, the Trustees will place the township's speed trailer at his driveway to record traveling speed data.
- The Sheriff's department stealth unit could also be used.

Lori Kannally from the Delaware County Health District provided several updates:

- COVID-19 has taken up most of their time, with current data being 399 cases (65 active) within the district. They are easing back into routine work.
- PPE distribution, and the sanitation/environmental health divisions are very busy.
- A survey is being conducted on COVID recovery patients.
- DKMM has added an additional recycling event.
- A picnic table raffle is being held; Mr. Johnson filled out the survey.
- Trustees requested information on current rules if they were to hold a zoning hearing, and an update on county fair restrictions.

Chairman Johnson certified Fiscal Officer Davis provided the financial reports of the township, and there is money in the treasury to pay bills. The current Cash Summary by Fund report shows the following balances:

- Nuisance case on Henderson Drive property owner cannot be located. The Prosecuting Attorney's office is assisting.
- Nuisance case on Brodie Blvd owner mowed 70% of lot. It complies for now.
- A couple of Epcon complaints were received about not being able to build quick enough. They are moving forward now.
- The township zoning tab and contact email on the website was discussed. People are having trouble finding information.
- A variance was received for a barn in front of a house, due to shape of lot.
 Trustees said meeting could be held with limited attendees due to COVID.
 Discussion was held on the code topic.

Road Department

- Mr. Holloway reported that Strawser Construction will begin road crack sealing on Friday July 1-2 and micro seal later. They will post on resident doors when their road is affected.
- No parking signs will be placed in Scioto Reserve on one side of the public road near the safety access gate. The gate would not swing open for safety vehicles. Chief will contact developer Chris Vince about the access on the private side. The Sheriff's office said they would not write a ticket for the parked cars unless the owner was present.
- The new tractor and mower works, but weights are needed on the front of the tractor. Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve purchase of tractor weights from Evolution Ag not to exceed \$2,000. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- Curb inlet rings will be ordered from State Highway Supply to use in Tartan Fields and other areas. Mr. Holloway will calculate an estimate, about \$2,000 for ten sets, plus a yard of concrete each.
- The Road Department is ready to start grader patching on various roads. Estimates for asphalt and roller rental were presented. Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve \$10,000 for the 2020 in-house grader patching project. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- The trash dumping court case from Lucy Depp is tomorrow. Joe Holloway will attend for the township.

Park Department

Russ Brown of BYAA shared that 300 kids joined for baseball this year. All fields
including Klondike Road are maxed out, and also behind the fire station. He is
still waiting for Time Warner to install the internet at the concession stand
which will be billed directly to BYAA. Trash service was requested for the
Klondike Road field.

Chairman Johnson extended thanks was appreciative for Jim's years of service for the township. He will be missed.

Chief estimates the other fire truck will need replaced in about 7-8 years.
- It was shared that a previous fire chief from Liberty Township passed away.

- Discussion was held on sanitizing the township building since meetings are inperson again. Cleaning will take place before and after meetings on surfaces, chairs, phone, etc.
- Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to enter into Executive Session per ORC 121.22 (G)(1) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official. Mr. Holloway was invited to the session for an employee review. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- The Trustees returned to Regular Session at 9:29 pm.
- Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve a 2% salary increase for Road Supervisor Joe Holloway. Vote: Haney-no, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- Motion was made by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Haney for Trustee Garrett to oversee the Road Department. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
