### **Call to Order**

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, August 8, 2016 at the Concord Township Administrative Building. Chairman Bart Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called, and Trustees Jason Haney, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson were present.

### **Minutes**

Mr. Haney moved, and Mr. Garrett seconded, to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held July 25, 2016. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

### **Public Input**

Residents, Leslie Ungerott of 5519 Haddington Drive, Tom McLoughlin of 10076 Archer Lane, and Shruti Gupta of 7101 Comber Court, asked for an update on the shared use path connection from Concord Township into Dublin. Currently Dublin and Concord Township have agreed on a plan developed by the Delaware County Engineer's office. This path will run on the west side of Concord Road and connect to the Dublin path at Deeside Drive. Concord Road will be shifted slightly to the east to accommodate a path going under the golf cart bridge. There will then be an at-grade crossing to connect the current path on the east side of Concord Road. Concord Township has approved \$30,000 of the \$150,000 total estimate of the project, and has asked Dublin to fund the balance.

Patty Thompson of 4176 Klondike Road, requested the Board address flooding near the culvert at Freshwater and Klondike Road which floods her pasture. Other homeowners have buried their culvert ditches resulting on excessive drainage onto her property. Ms. Thompson's father gave a thirty foot easement to the township years ago and a culvert pipe was put across the road. Mr. Garrett suggested she meet with Milt Link of Delaware Soil & Water since the township only handles water drainage from the road to the ditch; Soil & Water handles drainage across properties based on topography.

### **Old Business**

Mr. Haney discussed the special duty Sheriff deputy report from July. It seems when the deputies sit and run radar, it is not effective. Mr. Johnson noted the previous discussion with the Sheriff has resulted in more citations and lower speeds. The Trustees feel the special duty shifts are having an effect. The Board asked Mr. Cooper to set the speed trailer on Clark Shaw; speeding has been reported on the curve between 4:30-6:30 p.m.

It was noted that no action will be taken on a driveway on Bunty Station Road from road work eight years ago.

## **Zoning Department**

Mr. Irvine reported he is working with the Delaware County Assistant Prosecutor on a letter for the Dublin and Moore Road property owner with overgrown empty houses.

Mr. Irvine also spoke to CF Bank about the property at 7364 Dublin Road.

Two zoning variances and a few permits have been received.

# **Road/Park/Fire Departments**

Chief Cooper reported the generator for sale on GovDeals contained 800 gallons of off-road diesel. A used tank was purchased and 500 gallons pumped into it; the rest will be stored at McWherter Petroleum in Delaware.

The Rumpke dumpster contracts were all dissolved for the road, fire, and administration locations. Republic Waste dumpsters will now be used.

A resident on Clark Shaw reported a news story about maple tree infestations. No information could be found.

The current fire station lease was extended until June 2017. The lease contract was executed and returned to the City of Columbus.

Construction on the new fire station is going well. The Frontier pole was moved, the fire line needs re-worked, the concrete floor was poured, drains and concrete in the bays

today, then apron poured next. The steel package is scheduled to arrive on August 19. Mr. Haney said the block work is terrific. They will test concrete stains on Monday.

Chief Cooper suggested the fire department's Dodge Durango be replaced. The brakes went out recently. He noted the Dodge Dakota also needs replaced, and the road department could use an extra vehicle also, and that state bid prices are good. No action taken at this time.

Pavement construction continues on Tartan Fields Drive. A car parked on the road during construction was found to be owned by someone on vacation. The Sheriff took care of moving the vehicle.

Mr. Cooper mentioned the asbestos removal is complete, but an additional \$3300 was charged for debris removal from the pipe trench.

### Correspondence

The change orders for construction allowance use were received from Mull & Weithman Architects. Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the fire station Testing Services Allowance line item be reduced by \$7,163.90 for S&ME, and Soil Testing & Engineering Ltd, for additional geotechnical consultation and testing. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the fire station Utility Allowance line item be reduced by \$8745.97 for Ohio Edison moving the utility pole. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

A Columbia Gas construction incentive letter was received.

Bids for new mowers were received from two vendors, with two more to come. Fiscal Officer Davis will get lease options also, with maintenance cost and what is included.

### **Financial**

Chairman Johnson certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports for the township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances were: General Fund \$4,589,105.00, and all Special Revenue Funds (Motor Vehicle & Permissive License Tax, Gas Tax, Cemetery, Road, Fire) \$5,243,768.23.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, *Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve all pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1523, 12185-12229, totaling \$164,644.82. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.* 

As there was no further business, *Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to adjourn. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes. Johnson-yes.*
