Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, September 12, 2016 at the Concord Township Administrative Building. Vice Chairman Joe Garrett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called, and Trustees Jason Haney and Joe Garrett were present.

Minutes

Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held August 22, 2016. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes.

Public Input

Resident Jeff Holloway, 7410 Dublin Road, asked if there was any progress on the overgrown property at 7364 Dublin Road. The property continues to look bad and he believes squatters are residing there. Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine contacted the bank.

Old Business

Heath Smedley of Medicount reported to the Board that all paperwork was submitted for EMS billing. They are waiting for a confirmation letter on the Medicare filing. Hardware and software training was held last week, and an iPCR test file was received this morning for conversion. Once converted and the system live, EMS runs can be uploaded, and private insurance will begin trickling in thereafter. Any kind of EMS run will need a patient signature captured.

Regarding continued patrolling by the Sheriff's Department, *Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to continue hiring the Delaware County Sheriff's Department for 45 special duty shifts from now through the end of the year. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes.*

New fire station construction update: The steel contractors are holding up the project so Charter Hill started putting up beams to keep the project going. The block work cannot finish until the steel is done. The mezzanine and deck are scheduled for September 19. Concrete in the living area is okay, but the concrete floors in the bays and the exterior aprons have issues. The bay floors may be re-ground and the aprons grooved for correction. The contractor, Charter Hill, continues to do a great job and no change orders have been issued.

New Business

A resident request was received to place "no left turn" signage onto South Section Line Road from South Lake Hill Drive. After discussion, *Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the signage for the above request. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes*.

The Columbus Running Company requested to hold their January 14 and January 28, 2017 Frigid Runs at Concord Park. The Board agreed and also granted permission for concession stand use.

Zoning Department

Mr. Irvine reported a County building official cannot do an inspection of the overgrown properties at 6400 Dublin and 6328 Moore Roads, Delaware, Ohio, because they are inaccessible. He will send a letter to the property owner requesting nuisance abatement with a seven day response.

Mr. Haney moved to adopt a Resolution to declare the property a nuisance at 7364 Dublin Road, Delaware, Ohio, and based on ORC 505.87 (A),(B),(C),(D), a letter be sent to the homeowner to comply and have the property mowed. If no reply within seven days, the Township will have the property mowed and the charges placed on the property tax duplicate. Mr. Garrett seconded this motion. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes.

A complaint was received about a nuisance at 4956 Highlands Drive. Mr. Irvine will inspect.

Discussion was held on zoning procedures while Mr. Irvine is out of the office.

An email was received from the developer of Clarkshaw Moors, asking for a different size path and driveway divergence, forty feet from intersections. Written information states

that the five foot path was acceptable. Due to the zoning process, if the County Engineer makes changes, the developer has to come back for approval again. The minutes will be checked from the development approval meeting held December 11, 2014, as well as what Liberty Township approved.

Road/Park/Fire Departments

Chief Cooper noted the County Engineer's office declined to change the culvert at Eagle Creek for the homeowner. Based on data calculations, the new culvert should be fine to handle water, but the homeowner disagrees with the findings. Water backs up into their septic system even during normal rain events since the culvert size was reduced. The home has been there for many years without problems until the culvert was changed. Mr. Garrett recommended the Board draft a letter to the County since the issue does not make sense.

The Section Line Road culvert is also too small for the water load. The culvert at Bunty Station Road needs replaced within six months. The size (5'8") falls under the County Engineer's jurisdiction. They will replace the culvert with the same size based on hydro tests, and will correct the elevation during replacement. Seed, straw, pavement and easements would be the Township's responsibility.

Flu shots will again be available at Walgreens for township employees and officials through the end of November.

Joe Thomas of Metro Development will hold an informational meeting this Wednesday at 6:30pm at the township building. The meeting will be about plans to close Butts Road for six months during sewage treatment line construction.

It was noted the Epcon property (Yinger) on South Section Line was mowed north of the driveway to Butts Road.

The Shawnee Hills administrator has asked about EMS billing and joining the Republic Waste trash and recycling contract. The township's contract will be reviewed.

Questions were raised regarding the platted alleyways in Bellpoint. Who is responsible for downed trees in the alleys? Can the alleys be given back to property owners (half each)? The Prosecutor's office will be consulted.

A new fire hydrant installation was requested from a property owner building a home. The water lines are not the right size to install a hydrant and the property is within 800 feet of a hydrant at Harriott Road.

Financial

It was made a matter of record that Oller Cemetery lot 260, graves 3 and 4 were sold. Bank statements from August were provided to Trustees for review.

Vice Chairman Garrett certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports of the Township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances were: General Fund \$4,974,112.09, and all Special Revenue Funds (Motor Vehicle & Permissive License Tax, Gas Tax, Cemetery, Road, Fire) \$6,073,528.82.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, *Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve all pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1532-1535, 12265-12309, totaling \$385,653.53. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes.*

As there was no further business, *Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adjourn. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes.*
