CONCORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015. Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order, and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Jason Haney, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Public Input

Russ Yurg and Scott Wilburn, hot air balloon pilots in central Ohio, are looking for launch and landing fields in the area. The Township must check with its liability insurance policy and obtain an opinion from the county prosecutor's office before allowing hot air balloon activity at the park.

Old Business

Discussion was held on changes to the transient vendor (solicitor) policy as a result of State House Bill 49 that updated ORC 505.94. A resolution will be reviewed by the Board for action at the next meeting.

Mr. Johnson and Fiscal Officer Jill Davis met with Tom Gee of Burns Consulting, who represents the township's current health administrator, Jefferson Health Plan. Mr. Johnson shared the township's 2018 health insurance quote from Jefferson Health Plan was about \$44,000 per month to remain in the current self-funded plan (an increase of about \$10,000 per month). Both Johnson and Davis feel it may be best to leave all companies associated with the current OPEC/JHP health insurance debt and lawsuit, and start over. FormFire employee histories are being updated and due October 15 so new 2018 quotes can be obtained from new designated broker, Burnham & Flowers. Johnson and Davis also met with Todd Bollinger of CBIZ, an insurance broker in Dublin, Ohio. Mr. Bollinger was present to introduce himself and discuss insurance options, costs, and brand versus generic drug costs.

The annual Fall Festival and Fire Prevention Open House will be this weekend at the new fire station, 7990 Dublin Road. Harvest Hills Ministry may hand out free pumpkins to attendees.

New Business

Delaware County Road Improvement Program forms for 2018 are due November 22, 2017. The Trustees will hold a special meeting on November 15, 2017, beginning at the fire department, at 8:00 am (rain date of November 21, 2017) to review the roads for 2018 improvements. The Trustees would also like to bid the improvements separately for comparison. It was mentioned to work with adjoining townships in a joint effort for future improvements to Bunty Station Road.

Two quotes were received for sealing the township blacktop parking and driveway areas. After discussion, no action was taken.

Tornado sirens and DELCOM cell phone alerts were discussed. Residents can sign up for the alerts online. Information will be placed on the township website.

After discussion, Mr. Garrett moved to purchase parcel #42044001012000 in the amount of \$330,000, consisting of 10.03 acres on Bean Oller Road, adjacent/north of the Oller Cemetery, with ten (future cemetery) plots earmarked to the family of the Philip Keller Estate, and the new cemetery section marked as such. Mr. Haney seconded this motion. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. In addition, Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Haney seconded to authorize Trustee Joe Garrett to sign closing documents on behalf of the Concord Township Board of Trustees. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Mr. Cooper has already contacted Patridge Survey, Geotechnical Consultants and Lawyers Title about inspections and closing. The Trustees would like driveway addresses obtained for both the new parcel and the existing Oller Cemetery.

Zoning Department

Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine has issued about thirty (30) zoning permits this month, and noted political signs must be posted outside road right-of-ways. The motor

home on Brust Drive was removed. Discussion was held on animal and zoning rules (i.e. chickens).

October 11, 2017

Fire & Maintenance Department

Resignation of full-time maintenance department employee Ben Steiner was received today. Part-time maintenance employee Nathan Wilgus is obtaining his CDL license. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Haney seconded to accept the resignation of Ben Steiner effective today. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The township's culvert policy for private driveways was discussed. *Mr. Johnson moved to rescind the township driveway policy of 2008. Mr. Garrett seconded the motion. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.* Driveway culverts will be taken on a case by case basis.

Fire station update - Mr. Cooper talked to Mr. Boster of Charter Hill Construction yesterday, and met with him today. All final work will be done within three weeks: catch basins, grout cleaning, concrete grooving, occupancy permit documents, cracked shower pan. Living area floor coating and PA system were paid by the township, but included in the construction contract, so will be emailed to Mr. Boster for credit. Change orders discussed were door signs, hose reels moved, radiant heaters in bays raised.

The maintenance department completed the final grading and seeding behind the fire station. Mr. Haney mapped out new paths to connect to existing park pathways.

The used road grader was purchased from Kingston Township for \$5,600.

September fire and EMS run reports were received from Captain Kindell.

The new fire station won third place in the Firehouse national magazine.

The new medic truck is going to Las Vegas for a trade show, then will be received by the department to place in service.

Financial Report

EMS billing update - about \$45,800 has been received in EMS billing claims since January.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to adopt a Resolution to Accept the Amounts of Rates as determined by the Delaware County Budget Commission for 2018. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. The Trustees would like something placed on the website about the November road levy renewal.

Bank statements for September were reviewed and initialed.

Chairman Johnson certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports for the Township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances were: General Fund balance \$5,569,221.02, and Special Revenue Funds \$3,877,972.60 (Motor Vehicle License Taxes, Gas Tax, Cemetery, Road, and Fire Funds), all totaling \$9,447,193.62.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, *Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve all pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1659-1662, 13200-13258, all totaling \$402,507.47. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.*

As there was no further business, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to adjourn at 9:20 pm. Motion passed unanimously.

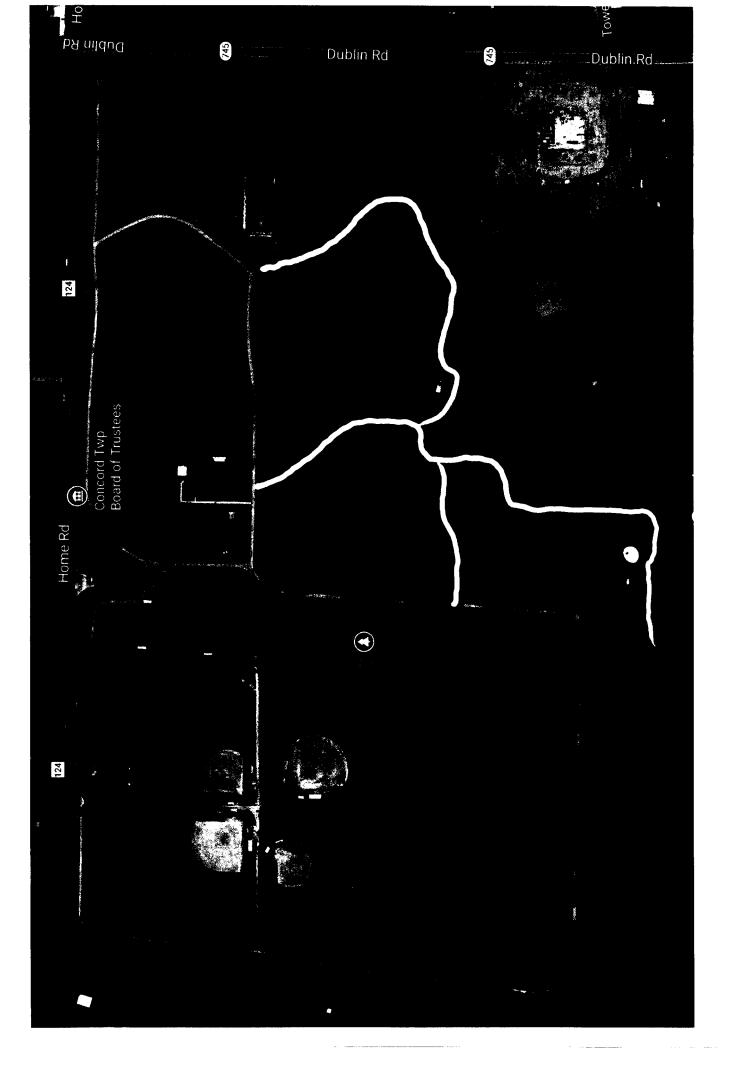
