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Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met Wednesday, November 22, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015. Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order, and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Jason Haney, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-abstain/absent.

Public Input

Guest Lori Kannally from the Delaware General Health District, gave an update on the community health assessment surveys, free community food safety trainings, and newborn home visits. Mr. Garrett noted the township can also do child seat safety checks. Mr. Johnson asked if the county health department would get involved with a community paramedicine program instead of the expense it would cost through the township fire department. Health department will do free neighborhood clinics by their nursing staff.

Old Business

The land closing for Bean Oller Road (Oller Cemetery expansion) was completed yesterday. Mr. Garrett discussed possible road extensions and grave expansion options.

Mr. Johnson gave an update of the health insurance lawsuit and what will be due by the end of the year. The Jefferson Health Plan (JHP) will cover our township health insurance through December 31, 2017. There was no run-out provision (estimated at ~\$95,000) built into the OPEC-HC plan, so the township will have to pay JHP for claims that are processed after December 31st (about 2/3 toward paying for claims, and about 1/3 to cover the re-insurance component for large claims >\$150,000). In addition, the township's portion of the OPEC-HC cooperative pool's debt/deficit is estimated at \$52,000 (about ~\$2,100 paid monthly for two years, to be escrowed). The township will also owe a fee to Medical Mutual at about \$150/employee to administer the run-out claims January through June 2018. The amounts are still pending court action, so more updates as the lawsuit progresses.

New Business

Mr. Johnson discussed new health insurance options and quotes received from two brokers, Burnham & Flowers and CBIZ. Mr. Johnson recommends a fully-insured plan through CBIZ; the United HealthCare network currently has the lowest increase.

An organizational meeting was scheduled for Thursday, January 4, 2018 at 9:00a.m. at the township building.

Financial Report

Chairman Johnson certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports for the Township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances were: General Fund balance \$5,271,268.25, and Special Revenue Funds \$3,449,619.54 (Motor Vehicle License Taxes, Gas Tax, Cemetery, Road, and Fire Funds), all totaling \$8,720,887.79.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, *Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve all pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1671-1675, 13318-13360, all totaling \$540,892.94. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.*

Road Department

The 2018 road improvement plans are due to the County Engineer today. Based on the Trustees' road inspections, the following roads will be planned for 2018 improvements: Archer, Clarkshaw, Cook, Dix, Duffy, Edgewood, Park Ridge, Grayson, and Klondike. Rivers Edge and Ladonna were also discussed for possible improvements.

Zoning Department

Zoning Inspector, Ric Irvine, reported eight permits were issued so far for November. He also received a call about a climate controlled barn wanting to hold

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activities. The Zoning Commission will meet on December 19, 2017 for the 25 acre parcel on the north side of Hyatts Road (Scioto Reserve expansion). Private condo road specs were also discussed.

Fire & Maintenance Department

Maintenance employee, Nathan Wilgus, passed his CDL license on first try.

Chief Cooper has asked Working Partners to develop an SOP guideline for who/when random drug and alcohol testing will be required.

Fire house construction update: roof runoff issue, grout still not cleaned and different colors, furnace operating loudly, LED lights recall and replacement. No final draw documents have been received.

Dead trees in Lucy Depp will be evaluated and removed, and road right-of-way determined next week.

The new Bean Oller Road property will not be cleaned up until next year.

The new medic and Quint trucks will be in the Delaware Christmas parade.

A portion of Clark Shaw Road was cleaned.

Part-time fire employees list and new hire progress was discussed.

New developments submitted to fire department: 1-the 15 lots for Merchant Road were proposing curb and gutter. Township will ask for modified/closed ditches instead. 2-the 8 lots for Brust Drive probably will not pass Regional Planning as drawn.

Reminder of township blood drive on January 6, 2018 at the fire station.

Other Business

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to adopt Resolution #112217-01, the second step in the cemetery reclamation process, stating that no owner responded to the Board by 5:00p.m. on November 5, 2017 regarding their interest in the advertised cemetery lots, and pursuant to ORC 517.073 the township has the right of reentry, hereby reclaims its interest, and shall henceforth establish reentry to the unused cemetery lots. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to adopt Resolution #112217-02, for the Board of Trustees to approve to enter into agreement with Verizon Wireless, for the lease of a portion (approximately 100' x 100', plus rights of way) of township property at 7990 Dublin Road, Delaware, Ohio for a new cellular tower, for a rental fee of \$1,100 per month, for an initial term of five years plus five consecutive five year automatic renewal terms. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Haney seconded to enter into Executive Session to discuss 1-the pending OPEC-HC lawsuit (per ORC 121.22(G)(3)), and 2-the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee (per ORC 121.22(G)(1). Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

The Trustees returned to Regular Session. As there was no further business, *Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.*





PREAMBLE

WHEREAS; in accordance with authority granted by Revised Code § 505.11 and Concord Township Zoning Resolution 6.031(IV), the Board desires to lease a portion of Board owned property located at 7990 Dublin Rd. Delaware, Ohio 43015, PIN # 60024003007003 ("Property") for the purpose of constructing a telecommunication tower; and

WHEREAS; NEW PAR, a Delaware partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Lessee"), is able and willing to meet the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Land Lease Agreement and any and all accompanying documentation ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS; the Board further finds that Concord Township would be benefitted from the Agreement; and

WHEREAS; any consideration received from the Agreement shall be payable, as prescribed in the Agreement, to the Concord Township Fiscal Officer, who shall give a receipt for the amount received and deposit it in the Concord Township general fund; and

WHEREAS; the Agreement sets forth the explicit terms and contingencies under which the Board will agree to lease the Property to Lessee; and,

WHEREAS; it is the desire of the Board to enter into the Agreement and have any necessary Board members, sign all necessary and required documents on behalf of the entire Board and in so doing bind the Board.

RESOLUTION

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Board unanimously approves and hereby adopts the attached Agreement for the purpose of leasing land to Lessee, and authorizes each of its members and the Concord Township Fiscal Officer to certify their approval of the Agreement by written signature on the Agreement.
- 2.
