Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met Wednesday, December 27, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Concord Township Administrative Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015. Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order, and the roll was taken. In attendance were Trustees Jason Haney, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-abstain/absent, Johnson-yes.

Public Input

Lori Kannally of the Delaware General Health District shared the following: there is an uptick of the norovirus "stomach flu" which is highly contagious so disinfect well, and also an uptick of the influenza flu (the flu vaccine has been about 40-60% effective).

Old Business

The 2018 Road Improvement estimate was received from the County Engineer's office. After discussion, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the 2018 township road improvement estimate for \$693,031.93. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett discussed the postmaster's recommendation for cluster mailboxes for new subdivisions. He thinks the cluster boxes are a detriment to a neighborhood, along with safety, inconvenience, and distance issues. Mr. Irvine has also been researching the recommendation, stating it is supposed to save costs for postal delivery and developer installation. Mr. Irvine will respond that the township would like individual mailboxes for new subdivision homeowners.

Zoning Department

Mr. Irvine reported twelve zoning permits were issued for December. An assessment inspection of the Montgomery property on South Section Line Road was ordered again for Tuesday, since open trusses are visible from the road and there are no longer tarps covering the structure.

New Business

Mr. Johnson moved to enter into Executive Session at 7:30 pm to discuss potential litigation due to a development plan change. Mr. Haney seconded this motion. Invited to the session were the Trustees, Fiscal Officer, Zoning Inspector, Zoning Commission Board Chairperson, Attorney, and Operations Director. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Johnson noted the Trustees returned to Regular Session at 9:37pm.

Financial Report

Chairman Johnson certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports for the Township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances were: General Fund balance \$5,186,055.67, and Special Revenue Funds \$2,993,234.14 (Motor Vehicle License Taxes, Gas Tax, Cemetery, Road, and Fire Funds), all totaling \$8,179,289.81.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve all pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1686-1691, 13399-13456, all totaling \$232,191.84. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Fire & Maintenance Departments

A new medical director contract through Ohio Health will not be ready until the end of January 2018, so Dr. Bambach will continue until then, at a rate of \$833 per month.

It was noted at the medical insurance meeting that chiropractic visits are not covered under the new medical plan. Our previous plan covered twelve visits. Options were discussed, and Mr. Johnson will call the agent.

Old fire gear will be placed on GovDeals tomorrow. The old helmets have no value since are not to current code, and will be discarded.

A change to the township building rental contract was requested, clarifying charitable groups must also be residents.

Fire station update - it is close to finished, and Chief Cooper will follow up with Charter Hill. An attorney letter was received regarding drywall issues and payment, which does not directly affect the township.

Tree removal quotes were reviewed, which include Lucy Depp trees surrounded by power lines, and one willow tree in Oller Cemetery. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve the tree removal quote in the amount of \$9,325.00, for removal of Lucy Depp trees, cut into firewood length, and one Oller Cemetery willow removal, haul away, and stump grinding. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Part-time fire employee hiring was discussed. Thirteen passed the agility testing; interviews are next.

Red Cross blood drive will be at the fire station on January 6, 2018.

Other New Business

Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve paying medical, dental, vision, and life insurance for full-time employees and elected officials on 2018. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to continue all ongoing contracts with current vendors into 2018. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to approve paying expenses for elected officials and employees who wish to attend the 2018 Ohio Township Association convention. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

It was noted the Trustee meetings will continue in 2018 on the second and fourth Wednesdays at 7:00 pm at the Concord Township Administrative Building. The organization meeting will be held Thursday, January 4, 2018 at 9:00 am.

Bank statements for certificate of deposit accounts were reviewed by the Trustees.

A fire department run history report was received through November 30, 2017: total calls 700, total reports 897.

As there was no further business, Mr. Haney moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.


Flu Update
Friday December 15 – Thursday, December 21

General:

The first and best way to protect against the flu is to get the vaccine. The flu vaccine can reduce flu illnesses, doctor's visits, and missed work and school, in addition to preventing flu-related hospitalizations. The CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older.

In addition to receiving a yearly flu vaccine, staying away from sick people and washing your hands reduces the spread of germs including the flu. If you are sick with the flu, stay home to help prevent further spread.

Vaccine effectiveness can vary, but recent studies show that the vaccine reduces the risk of flu illness by 40-60% among the overall population.


