Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, January 25, 2016 at the Concord Township Administrative Building. Chairman Bart Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The roll was called and attending were Trustees Jason Haney, Joe Garrett, and Bart Johnson.

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve the minutes from the previous meeting January 11, 2016, with one change noted. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Public Input

Mike Darling of Rumpke spoke to the Trustees regarding the trash contract decision. He stated Rumpke has been around for a long time in the Township, and their customer service means a lot, even though they were not the lowest bid. He said the low bid would not be low forever.

Old Business

Trash Contract: The trash contract decision was discussed. The Trustees received more positive correspondence since the public input meeting, and felt they would be disappointing the community if they did not do a contract. Mr. Garrett contacted the Prosecutor's office and was told a trash contract cannot be placed on a ballot per Ohio Revised Code. Mr. Haney stated the township went to the residents twice, once as an informal survey, and once as a township-wide postcard mailing, and about 85% of the residents were in favor both times.

Therefore, Mr. Garrett moved to enter into contract negotiations for township-wide trash and recycling service with Republic Waste. Mr. Haney seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Comprehensive Land Use Plan: Mr. Johnson noted a very good work session was held on January 16, 2016 with the Zoning Commission regarding the draft Comprehensive Plan (the "Plan"). Productive discussion was held, and the following consensus reached for Plan revisions:

--Density maximum at two units per acre gross, minus existing road right-of ways and road easements, to be defined in the Comprehensive Plan, with deductions capped at ten percent (less gross), and to incorporate into neighborhood plans increased density (up to two) for condo type units. A development would still need to meet zoning regulation incentives to get additional density up to two units per acre.

--Other minor changes include the striking of the Hyatts Road open ground section, and the amendment/reflection that the City of Columbus now owns the property at the southeast corner of Dublin and Home Roads. The Trustees would still like to encourage commercial/retail use on the site if the City of Columbus does not need the entire plot for a water treatment facility.

Mr. Haney moved to approve the Comprehensive Plan with revisions as noted above. Mr. Garrett seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

In addition, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded that the Buckeye Valley elementary school site (north of Bellpoint) be addressed in the new Comprehensive Plan. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

As a matter of record, the Board of Trustees thanked the Plan citizen committee, Regional Planning Commission, and Zoning Commission for all their time and effort putting together the updated Plan.

Applying for an Ohio Public Works Commission grant was considered for the improvement and widening of Clark Shaw Road. Metro Development hopes to have sewer and subdivision roads completed by October 2016 for Clarkshaw Moors and the two adjoining developments. Heavy truck use of Clark Shaw Road will take place during that time. The township can apply for the OPWC grant in 2016 for approval in 2017, or apply in 2017 for approval in 2018. To avoid damage to new road improvements, the Trustees tabled the grant application until they have a better idea when the heavy truck traffic will subside.

Zoning Department

Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine reported four permits were issued in December and five in January. The total permits for 2015 were 117 (about 30% for new homes).

The new zoning fee schedule is now in effect.

Mr. Irvine has received several questions from people interested in building in Lucy Depp. Since the lots are irregular sizes, there is not much the township can do unless people first get approval for septic from the county health department, then file with the Board of Zoning Appeals for a lot variance.

Operations Director

Fire Chief and Operations Director, Todd Cooper, reported the following:

- --The trash contract was discussed with Shawnee Hills' Clerk (Shirley). They may be interested in joining Concord if the contract was written to allow add-ons.
- --The annual appointment of members to the Volunteer Firefighters Dependent Fund Board was held. Mr. Johnson moved to appoint Trustees Garrett and Haney to the Board. Mr. Garrett seconded the motion. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- —Correspondence was received from a resident about Del-co's excavating work on Home Road. Could a walking path be installed along Home Road above the new water lines? Mr. Garrett responded that the head of Olentangy/Liberty Trails approached Del-co, but their easement is only for underground work, not above ground. To install a path across the properties, easements (above ground) would be needed from each homeowner. If easements were obtained, the township may be interested in putting in a path, but crossing the pond would be cost prohibitive. Mr. Johnson noted a path from Tree Lake Boulevard to the Concord/Liberty line could be done by Concord Township.
- --Mr. Garrett would like to formally invite Del-co to attend a meeting to discuss water availability in the township and water pressure along US 42.
- --Chief Cooper proposed the hiring of Dr. Dennis Bambach to continue as EMS director for 2016. Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to hire Dr. Bambach as 2016 EMS director for an annual fee of \$10,000. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- --Chief Cooper requested Certified Rescue Tech training at BGSU for permanent part-time firefighters Beau Hammock and Josh Hall. The training is 200 hours (27 hours as educational on-duty), at a cost of \$2,900 per person, from March to August 2016. Since the employees are part-time and the cost is high, the Trustees discussed how to protect the training investment with a tuition payback. Mr. Garrett moved to approve Certified Rescue Tech training for firefighters Hammock and Hall, at a cost of \$2,900 each, with a tuition payback agreement as follows: If the two firefighters do not stay employed by the township for forty shifts minimum per year, the tuition is paid back 100% if leave within one year, 66% within two years, 33% within three years. Mr. Haney seconded the motion. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- --The township building was rented six times within two days last week, and a programmable locking system and options were discussed. More details to come.
- --Delaware County has reserved the Concord Park ball fields for their annual softball tournament August 27-28, 2016.
 - --Chief noted firefighter Ben Thomas is off until May due to an off-duty injury.

- --A complaint was received regarding an ice jam at the storm drain on Fairfield Lakes. The road department will evaluate to ensure correct fall of concrete when it melts.
- -The March Trustees meeting is scheduled the same evening the Elections board needs to set up for voting. The meeting will be held, but moved to a different room.
 - --Dates for the 2016 Fall Festival were discussed, possibly October 1 or 15.
- —The webmaster is in the process of adding new Trustees Jason Haney to the website. A photo is needed.
- --Chief noted EMS Coordinator Jim Reed has stepped down from his position. The position has been opened for interviews.
- --Two quotes were received from Frontier for the new fire station phone system, \$11,404.52 with and \$9,387.34 without wiring installed. It was noted Frontier is also moving the pole for the township. Other expenses for the fire station that are not included in the construction bid were discussed, including architect, septic, and appliances.

Fiscal Officer Jill Davis shared correspondence received from the following:

- --The Trustees were invited to the Delaware County Habitat for Humanity's 56th Home Dedication Ceremony for the Kroninger Family on Saturday, January 30, 2016 at 3:00 pm at 55 David Street, Delaware, OH.
 - --Another email was received in favor of a trash contract to benefit the community.
- --The property tax invoice was received for the new fire station property at 7990 Dublin Road. The tax exemption filed last year was acknowledged by the County Auditor's office, but not approved yet by the State. The County advised Mrs. Davis not to pay.

Financial

Chairman Johnson certified the Fiscal Officer provided current financial reports for the township. The current Cash Summary by Fund balances are: General Fund \$4,277,482.93, and all Special Revenue Funds \$5,609,371.58.

The Fiscal Officer certified funds have been appropriated and money is in the treasury to pay the bills. Therefore, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to approve pending purchase orders, vouchers, and warrants #1457-1464, 11687-11728, all totaling \$280,308.35. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

As there was no further business, Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Haney seconded to adjourn. Vote: Haney-yes, Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
