Call to Order

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Wednesday, June 24, 2026 at the Concord Township Community Building, 6385 Home Road, Delaware, Ohio. Chairman Bart Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called: Jason Haney-absent, Joe Garrett-present, Bart Johnson-present. Trustee Garrett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve the minutes of the June 19, 2026 special meeting. Vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.
- Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2026 regular meeting with changes as noted. Vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Public Input

Ms. Lori Kannally of the Delaware Public Health District (DPHD) shared information on resources available to Township residents: a trail forum survey, cleaning and sanitation items available for loan for community events, a weekly heat watch email, mosquito prevention, poison hemlock warnings, electronic recycling event June 27, tire disposal event July 18, a walking event for adults 55+ July 27, a blood drive August 3, a baby expo August 8, and health alerts by email. More information on these programs is attached as well as available on the Delaware Public Health District website, delawarehealth.org.

A resident asked what could be done about semi trucks using Moore Road, since the trucks are causing damage to the roadway and presenting safety issues for local residents. Construction on State Route 42 is the main cause of this increased traffic, and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will need to update the information provided to GPS systems so traffic is not routed this way. Ultimately the Township cannot take any action on this, as Moore Road is a county road, not a township road.

Mr. Doug Riedel, senior engineer and Township liaison from the Delaware County Engineer’s Office, shared updates on various road projects affecting the Township:

- A crosswalk will be painted on the south leg of State Route 745 where it intersects with Home Road, to connect the paths on either side of Rt. 745.
- Road improvements and resurfacing are taking place in Delaware County according to the schedule on the Delaware County Engineer’s website. Email notifications will be sent in advance of any road improvement work affecting Concord Township.
- Bids will open on June 30 for the OPWC repaving project in the Lucy Depp neighborhood. Mr. Riedel expects to have a contract and a tentative schedule to present for review in July. The project will likely take place in Spring 2027.
- Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adopt Resolution #26-0624-1 (attached) in support of the Delaware County designed roundabout at State Route 745 and Home Road in Rathbone. Upon roll call vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

Financial Report

Mr. Johnson certified Fiscal Officer Davis provided financial reports to the Board, and money is available to pay bills. The current Cash Summary by Fund shows the following balances:

Mr. Garrett moved and Mr. Johnson seconded to approve pending vouchers, warrants and purchase orders #80-87, #119675 void, 119701-119719, all totaling \$264,071.64. Vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

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Zoning Department

Zoning Inspector Ric Irvine provided the following updates:

- Zoning Permits issued since the previous report: 2 single family residences, 3 additions, 1 accessory building, 1 revision, 1 ag variance. Total of 8 permits.
- The zoning complaint about cars parked in front of 5461 Dublin Road has reportedly been resolved. Mr. Irvine will confirm.
- The owner of a property at 7707 Glenmore Drive has been notified of a zoning complaint about mowing the property. The property owner has a few days left to resolve.
- A property owner on Gwendolyn Drive has been sent a first notice of a zoning complaint regarding a vehicle on the property.
- A resident has made a public records request regarding the zoning complaint on 4785 Maynard Road, which has been determined not to be in violation. Fiscal Officer Jill Davis is handling this request.
- A zoning complaint has been filed and a public records request received regarding storage containers on a property under construction. There was discussion about the existing zoning permit for these containers, as well as possible zoning code changes going forward. Trustee Garrett recommended consulting legal counsel.

Road/Cemetery/Park Department

Road Supervisor Nathan Wilgus provided the following updates:

- One person has applied for the part time road position. Mr. Wilgus will contact.
- Mr. Wilgus gave a brief update on various road department projects, including curb work, catch basins, paving, and grass seeding.
- Trustee Garrett has received an inquiry from a resident about maintenance of a retention pond near Heather Ridge Drive and Shadowfair Lane. Mr. Wilgus advised the pond is owned by the neighborhood's Homeowner's Association, and they are responsible for its maintenance.

Old Business

- Discussion on the Mills Cemetery wall repair was tabled due to Trustee Haney's absence, no action taken.
- There was discussion on significant roof repairs needed at the Township Administrative Building. ASI Roofing has submitted a quote. A commercial window company would also be needed to coordinate repair work.
- Gates have been installed to restrict vehicular access from the Road Department parking lot to the park and pickleball courts. GPS systems are incorrectly routing drivers this way, and the paths connecting the Road Department and the park are not designed for vehicular traffic. Trustee Garrett reiterated that ODOT should be contacted to update the GPS routes.

New Business

- The Eversole Run Middle School cross country team would like to use Concord Park for cross country events on September 8 and 22. The ball association will be contacted to check for possible conflicts with fall ball season.
- There was a conversation about identifying graves of Revolutionary War veterans buried in Concord Township.
- Trustee Garrett shared that people visiting gravesites at Oller Cemetery have asked if veterans' markers could be moved to be more clearly associated with the veteran's grave. Markers are currently placed at the foot of a grave, sometimes directly in front of the next row's headstone. There was discussion on feasibility and practicality of this request. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to begin the process of moving existing

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veterans' markers and install future markers either on the reverse side of the headstone when possible, or directly behind the headstone. Vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes. Mr. Garrett will also work on updating the cemetery rules and regulations.

Fire Department

Fire Chief Todd Cooper provided the following updates:

- There was a discussion about the Fire Department's assistance with a serious accident on Father's Day at the intersection of State Route 42 and South Section Line Road.

Fiscal Officer Report

Fiscal Officer Jill Davis provided the following updates:

- A final Trustee review of the Comprehensive Plan will be scheduled soon, likely in July.
- There was a discussion on the status of the Hill Cemetery easement; no update.
- Correspondence was received from the Delaware County Commissioners regarding an assessment of \$4,282 for the Watson-Ford Drainage Improvement project. The Trustees agreed this should be processed for payment.
- There was a conversation about the 1.0 mill road levy expiring at the end of 2026. Mr. Johnson moved and Mr. Garrett seconded to adopt Resolution #2026-0624-2 (attached) to declare a necessity to levy a 1.0 mill renewal tax for five years in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of roads and bridges in the township, to be placed on the November 3, 2026 ballot, to be first levied in 2027 and first collected in 2028, and directing the Fiscal Officer to obtain a certificate of estimated tax revenue from the County Auditor for such. Vote: Garrett-yes, Johnson-yes.

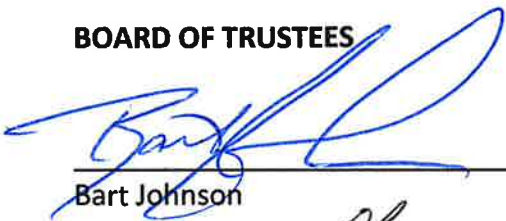
Adjournment

**A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY TO LEVY A RENEWAL
TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF
GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND
REPAIR OF ROADS AND BRIDGES
(R.C. §§ 5705.03, 5705.19(G), 5705.191, and 5705.25)**

The Board of Trustees of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio ("Board")
met in regular session on June 24, 2026 with the following members

Mr. Johnson Moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes that will be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of Concord Township, Delaware County, Ohio ("Township"); and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation; and

WHEREAS, the levy would be a renewal levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of roads and bridges, said purpose being authorized by R.C. § 5705.19(G); and,

WHEREAS, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying such a tax outside the ten-mill limitation must be approved and certified to the Delaware County Auditor ("Auditor") requesting the Auditor certify to the Board certain amounts as required by R.C. § 5705.03(B)(1) and (2).

RESOLUTION

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board, at least two-thirds (2/3) of all of the members of the Board concurring, as follows:

1. The amount of taxes that will be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Township.
2. It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation.
3. Pursuant to R.C. § 5705.03(B)(1):

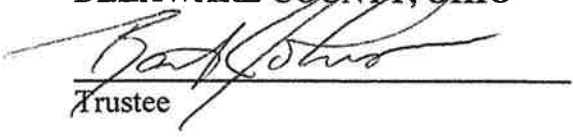
